



SPRING REP TRYOUTS 2011-12

IMPORTANT INFORMATION....

On January 23, 2011 the Ontario Minor Hockey Association had a special meeting to discuss a proposal from OHF to allow None Resident Players. The motion was passed and the following are the highlights of that Motion (for full details visit the OntMHA website at www.omha.net) .

- a) Movement to AA or A is only permitted for participants Minor Peeewe age and above. Note: To be eligible the player is required to be the Minor Peeewe age (11 years old) or older as at December 31 of the current playing season; OMHA Regulation 3.6 is NOT applicable.
- b) Movement is only permitted to a higher level for players from A and below base category Centres. Note: There shall be NO lateral movement (ie: A to A, AA to AA)
- d) Maximum number of "Non Resident Players" (NRP) is three per eligible team. Once a team has rostered an NRP then NO replacement NRP will be permitted.
- e) Other than at a player's Home Centre, the number of tryouts is limited to two other categories. For his first opportunity, a player has the right to choose to tryout at AAA as per OMHA regulations, but this tryout is not mandatory. The second opportunity, a player must tryout for a AA team at a AAA or AA base category Centre or an A team at an A base category Centre. A player's tryout will only be permitted for the base category team in a Centre.

1. A player from an OMHA BB base category Centre and below may tryout for

- a) AA Zone as per the current regulations
- b) One AA team in a AAA or AA base category Centre nearest to his residence OR one A team in an A base category Centre nearest to his residence AND
- c) Home Centre

2. A player from an OMHA A base category Centre may tryout for

- a) AAA Zone as per the current regulations
- b) One AA team in an OMHA AAA or AA base category Centre nearest his residence AND
- c) Home Centre

Orillia Minor Hockey has decided to be an open centre allowing "Non Resident Players" to tryout at our centre.



New rules have come out with regards to when AAA tryouts must be completed. The following is from Ontario Minor Hockey:

Monday, December 06, 2010

Toronto, ON: - On Saturday November 13, 2010 the Ontario Hockey Federation Minor Council passed a motion with respect to tryouts in the OHF at the AAA level. The motion reads:

Tryouts at the AAA level must be completed within 14 days following the OHF Championships with successive tryouts at the AA and A levels to follow.

The 14 day timeframe commences on the first Monday following the completion of the OHF Minor Hockey Championships. The OHF Championships are conducted the weekend of the second Saturday in April each year.

The above applies to all AAA except Midget.

Tryouts at the AA and A can start on completion of AAA tryouts or if the divisions are working together in joint tryouts.

Orillia Minor Hockey will commence tryouts for the 2011-12 season starting April 29, 30, May 3, 4, 6, 7, 13, 14, 15 - "A" Teams will receive three tryouts followed by the "AE" Teams.

The cost for Tryouts is \$ 50.00 per player with \$ 15.00 of this fee being divided equally amongst all Rep Teams.

Online Registration for Representative Tryouts will open on April 14 - 29, 2011. The hockey office will be taking registration during normal business hours.

Please make sure that your players are made aware of the changes to our program and the introduction of Spring Tryouts. Rep Coaching Applications are online at our website at www.orilliahockey.com or can be picked up at the hockey office - the completed application must be back to the hockey office by March 15, 2011.

Our program is in need of Additional Entry Coaches at the Rep Level - If you have been a house league coach and want to try Rep Hockey this is a great step!

Rep Coaching interviews will take place the end of March and the Coaches will be announced at the Annual Banquet on April 16, 2011.

Tryout Schedules will be posted on our website closer to Tryouts - you must be pre registered to attend Tryouts!

The information above is only for those players wishing to tryout for a representative team for the 2011-12 season. Registration for house league will take place in mid August.
