### HOCKEY REGISTRATION (On-Line and Walk-In)

for those that do not want to attend a walk-in registration. Commencing on June 12, 2006 registration on-line will be open for ALL PLAYERS wishing to register for the 2006-07 season with Orillia Minor Hockey. During these dates you will be able to go to the hockey website at [www.orilliahockey.com](http://www.orilliahockey.com) to access the online registration link. Payment for on-line registration is **credit card only**. Registration is limited, please register early to avoid disappointment.

On-Line-Orillia Minor Hockey has embarked on a new registration process

**Walk-In-** Orillia Minor Hockey is offering the following dates **ONLY** for those individuals who want to register at the hockey office—**Tuesday, June 13, 2006, Wednesday, June 14, 2006, Tuesday, June 20, 2006 and Wednesday, June 21, 2006 from the hours of 9:00 a.m.—5:00 p.m.** The hockey office is located at the Community Centre. **Payment at walk-in registration must be cheque or money order, cash or credit card will not be accepted and payment is due the day of registration.** Please make cheques payable to Orillia Minor Hockey Association. A \$ 25.00 fee will be charged for returned cheques from any financial institution. Players **do not** need to accompany their parents/guardians to walk-in registration.

**Outstanding Fees-** Individuals having equipment, sweaters or outstanding fees will not be allowed to register until the return/payment of any outstanding items a note to those individuals with outstanding items would have accompanied this Newsletter.

**Late Registration—**On June 23, 2006 the link to ITSportsNet will be removed. After a review of our numbers a late registration may be scheduled. If a late registration is warranted the link will be reinstated on **August 1 to 18, 2006 and you will be allowed to register on-line ONLY.** During this round of registration a **\$ 50.00 late fee will be in effect.** Registration could be limited to certain age divisions based on numbers. To avoid any confusion the registration fee that you see in the system will already have the \$ 50.00 late fee added. This \$ 50.00 late fee applies to ALL REGISTRANTS whether you are a New or Returning Player.

**Family Discount—**Families registering three or more players will receive a \$ 50.00 discount per player starting with the third player. The system automatically applies this discount to the third child registered whether that child is a returning player or a new player to Orillia Minor Hockey.

**New Registrants/Orillia Minor Hockey Players that have Moved—**If you are new to Orillia Minor Hockey you must provide a copy of the players Birth Certificate, proof of residency (landlord name/tax bill) with your registration. If you are moving to Orillia from another center a letter stating you are a member in good standing is needed with your registration. **New Registrants and those Orillia players that have changed addresses from last season** must also fill out a Residential Questionnaire which can be found on the Orillia Minor Hockey website. If you are registering on-line you must submit the above documentation within **7 days** of registering to Orillia Minor Hockey Association, P.O. Box 731, Orillia, ON L3V 6K7. If the required information is not received within the 7 days your information will be removed from the system and you will have to re-enter the player information possibly during the late registration provided spots are available.

**User Fees—**Payment of Non-Resident User Fees are **Mandatory** for those individuals that reside outside of the City of Orillia or do not pay City of Orillia taxes. If you reside in Severn Township and pay your taxes to Severn you must pay the additional \$ 50.00 per player. If you reside in other Townships such as Oro-Medonte, Ramara, Rama and all Others the Non-Resident Fee is \$ 100.00 per player.

Failure to pay the appropriate fee at on-line registration will result in your registration being removed from the system and a \$ 50.00 Administrative Fee for reactivation. You will have to re-enter the player information possibly during the late registration provided spots are available.

**Representative Tryout Fees-** If a player is wanting to tryout for a Representative Team you must choose the on-line Representative Tryout Fee icon. The cost for tryouts is \$ 15.00 per player. **Only those players who pre pay the Representative Tryout Fee will be allowed on the ice at Tryouts. Please bring to tryouts the receipt generated by the on-line program as proof of payment.** For those registrants that attend a walk-in registration payment for Tryouts will be collected at that time and a receipt will be issued to present at tryouts.

**No player will be allowed at Tryouts without proof of payment of Tryout Fees.**

**"New" Representative Fee Collection—**Once a player is confirmed to have made a Rep Team they must provide a cheque/money order to the Manager of the Team in the amount of \$ 240.00. **Cheques to be made out to Orillia Minor Hockey and dated October 1, 2006.** Managers are to forward the collected fees to the hockey office. **Approved Rosters will not be given out to Teams until all Rep Fees are collected for each player and submitted to the hockey office.**

**Refund Policy—**A request for a refund of a portion of the registration fee for a person who ceases to play Orillia Minor Hockey prior to the end of the calendar year due to **medical reasons or relocation** may be submitted in writing to the Administrative Assistant. **A \$ 25.00 Administration Fee will be applied against all refunds.**

**DON'T BE DISAPPOINTED—REGISTER EARLY...due to the increasing number of players and the limited availability of ice, players will be accepted on a first come first serve basis, as received by the Administrator. The surplus will be placed on a waiting list.**

## House League Coaches 'REQUIRED'

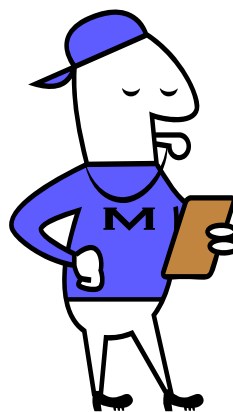

- ◆ Training and scheduling students to work all Rep Games
- ◆ Arranging pick up and drop off of gate boxes
- ◆ Preparation of daily gate sheets
- ◆ Responsible for large amounts of money and reconciling gate sheets
- ◆ Keeping change in float for gates (trips to the bank)
- ◆ Contacting Ice Scheduler for schedules and updates

## From the Equipment Room

There have been several cases this year of “abused”/“ruined” jerseys that were returned from various house league and representative teams. This requires the replacement of these sweaters and it is unnecessary and costly. The life expectancy of an Orillia Minor Hockey jersey is approximately four years, provided they are washed regularly, hung to dry (not put in the dryer) and NEVER put back in a jersey bag wet/damp. When a jersey is put away it will grow mold on the material, this mold does not wash out or dry clean away. Coaches are responsible for making sure that sweaters are kept in a well maintained manner, failure to look after them costs everyone!

Players and coaches that still have outstanding sweaters and/or equipment will not be allowed to register until they are returned. Please contact Susan at the hockey office at 326-6642 to arrange a time to drop off any outstanding sweaters or equipment.
